## Base Access:


Access to NSF Dahlgren requires a valid Common Access Card (CAC), military ID, Government-issued Personal Identity Verification card (Gov PIV), or Transportation Worker Identification Card (TWIC). Course participants who do not have one of these forms of ID must contact a course host POC identified above no later than 6 January 2014. A Visitor Authorization Request (VAR) is not required.

Class entry at the course location, JD's Conference Center, requires only a valid picture ID (e.g., driver's license.)

## Driving Directions from the Washington Area:

### Option 1

- Take I-95 South towards RICHMOND.
- Exit onto Rte. 3 East (Bypass)/Exit 130 towards FREDERICKSBURG.
- Travel approx. 3 miles. Road will “T” at Rte 3. Just prior, merge right onto Rte. 3 East.
- Travel 16 miles towards KING GEORGE. Make a left at the traffic light onto Rte. 206 (Fas Mart convenience store And King George High School on left.)

- You will reach a major intersection after 9.2 miles, at Rt. 301 (WaWa gas station immediately on your right.) Continue straight through the traffic light.
- After 2 miles, this road (Dahlgren Road) terminates at the Main Gate and Visitors Center.
- A valid CAC card provides base access; without a CAC, stop at the Visitors Center on the right of the gate to get your visitors pass.
- Follow the directions provided below under: On-Base Driving Directions to JD's...

### Option 2 – From Dulles Airport

- Take the Dulles Access Road (Rte. 267) to I-495 South/Capital Beltway via Exit 18 toward RICHMOND/ALEXANDRIA.
- Follow I-495 into Maryland and exit onto MD-5 S via exit number 7A toward WALDORF.
- Drive through the towns of Waldorf and LaPlata (35 - 45 minutes).
- Cross the Harry W. Nice Bridge (\$6.00 toll) into Virginia.
- Make a left at the 2nd Light - Rte 206 (Dahlgren Rd—there is a 7-Eleven to the left and Burger King to the right.)
- After 2 miles, this road (Dahlgren Road) terminates at the Main Gate and Visitors Center.
- A valid CAC card provides base access; without a CAC, stop at the Visitors Center on the right of the gate to get your visitors pass.
- Follow the directions provided below under: On-Base Driving Directions to JD's...

### **Driving Directions from the Richmond, VA Area:**

- Take Rte I-95 North approx. 20 miles to Rte 301.
- Take a right onto Rte 301 North.
- Follow Rte 301 North 26 miles to the intersection with Rte 206 (Burger King to the left and 7-Eleven to the right.)
- After 2 miles, this road (Dahlgren Road) terminates at the Main Gate and Visitors Center.
- A valid CAC card provides base access; without a CAC, stop at the Visitors Center on the right of the gate to get your Visitors Pass.
- Follow the directions provided immediately below:

### **On-Base Driving Directions to JD's Training and Conference Facility (Bldg 216):**

#### From the Main Gate:

- Continue on Dahlgren Rd. until you see the Credit Union on the right.
- Turn right at the first road past the NFCU Federal Credit Union (Jenkins Road).
- Continue through the stop sign (after stopping, of course) on Jenkins Road past the Commissary and the 16" Gun at the end of the parade field.
- Turn right on Welch Road (residential area).
- JD's Training and Conference Center is at the end of the residential area (and before you get to the golf course.) There is limited parking behind this facility, and ample parking at the base theater, on your right two blocks before you reach the Conference Center.

#### From Bldg. 962 (BEQ):

- From Dahlgren Road enter the 3-way Intersection onto Caffee Road.
- Turn left onto Jenkins Road.
- Drive past the base commissary and the large naval gun display at the north end of the parade field.
- Turn right onto Welch Road (residential area).
- JD's Training and Conference Center is at the end of the residential area (and before you get to the golf course.) There is limited parking behind this facility, and ample parking at the base theater, on your right two blocks before you reach the Conference Center.


### **Driving on Base Information:**

- The Visitors Center (next to Main Gate) opens at 0630 Monday through Friday. Inbound traffic can back up outside gates between 0700 and 0900. **Please plan to arrive approximately 30 minutes early to allow for local and gate traffic.**
- All vehicles may be subject to search upon entry. Additionally, while traveling on base, random vehicle stop-and-searches are occasionally conducted.
- **Speed Limit on Base is 25 mph unless posted.** This is strictly enforced.
- **Do not use cell phones/listening devices while driving.** Driver use of a hand-held cellular phone in a moving vehicle is prohibited on base. Additionally, driver use of any portable, personal listening device while operating a motor vehicle is prohibited. Listening devices include wired and wireless earphones and headphones (including blue tooth or similar technology). Not subject to restrictions are hearing aids and devices designed for hearing protection.
- Use of listening devices while running on base roads is also forbidden.
