SUBJECT: Meal Allowance

EFFECTIVE DATE: Immediately

Summary: Current policy allows meal rates based on the JSAT 11-48. We understand these rates are outdated for some locations. The guidance below provides current guidance on meal rates.

1. Reference: 11-48. Paying Agent:

b. IMS meal allowance is \$25 a day. The only exception is \$30 a day for the Washington, DC, trips. These amounts are based on the following estimates (guidelines only):

(1) Breakfast-\$4 to \$5.

(2) Lunch-\$6 to \$7.

(3) Dinner-\$15 to \$18. Total is fixed; allocation to specific meals is dictated by circumstances.

Action:

Meal rates should be based on the JFTR, these rates can be found at the following link:

If one or more meal is on a military installation or is paid through the Field Studies Program, the proportional meal rate applies for that day.
