1. The JSAT provides policies, procedures and responsibilities for the training of foreign personnel implements the SAMM, DoD 5105.38-M.
2. The SATP consists of U.S. military training assistance to eligible countries under the FAA and AECA. Includes: IMET, FMS training, PME exchanges, unit exchanges, etc.
